The vineyard of **Château Belair L'Escudier** is located in the village of Lansac, in the heart of the Côtes de Bourg appellation, within a rolling landscape close to the Gironde estuary. The estate covers 11 hectares on a distinctive terroir characterized by veins of fine gravel combined with red and brown clay soils — a valuable qualitative asset that contributes to the optimal ripeness of the grapes and the depth and structure of the wines.

A deep, intense purple hue introduces a beautifully expressive bouquet of ripe blackcurrant and Morello cherry. The palate is generous and layered, revealing luscious dark fruit framed by silky, perfectly integrated tannins. The texture is supple yet structured, leading to a harmonious and lingering finish.
